



TEEN LIBRARY CARD APPLICATION

Teens between the **ages of 13 and 17** are eligible for a library card with ID and proof of address. If your ID does not have your address, library staff can help with address verification. If you do not have an ID or proof of address, a parent/guardian signature is also acceptable.

Acceptable ID for teenagers includes:

- Valid State Driver's License / Identification Card
- School ID / Report Card / Homework
- Photo ID Transit Card / City ID
- First Class mail addressed to the patron (postmarked within 30 days)
- Permanent Resident Card
- Matricula Consular ID
- Social Security Card / Passport
- Current medical identification card
