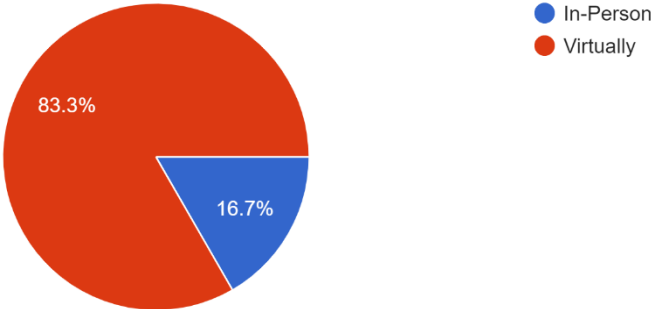

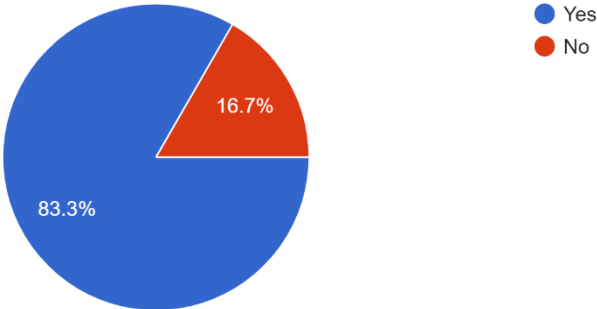
Please indicate your preference for LAC (including sub-committee) meetings.

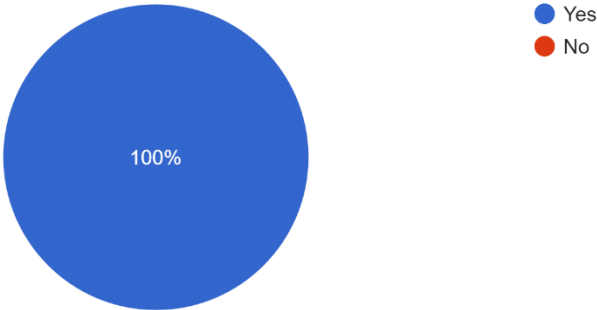
If LAC returns to in-person meetings, will you remain on the commission?

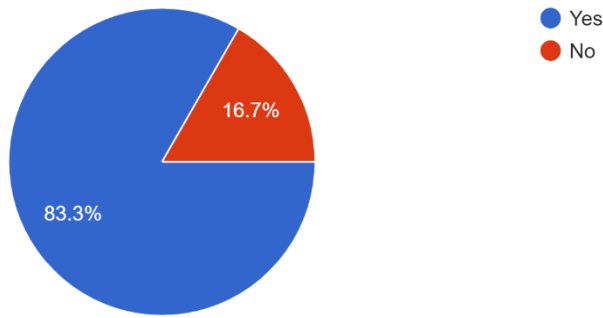
If LAC continues virtual meetings, will you remain on the commission?

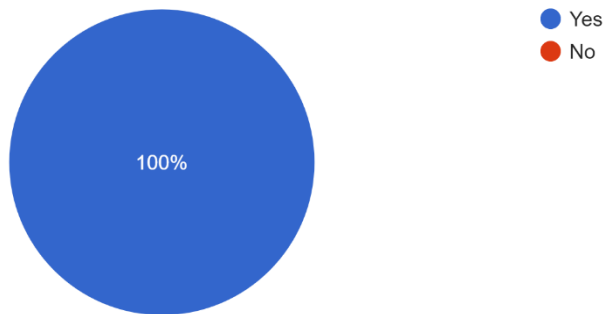
If LAC returns to in-person meetings, will you attend each meeting?
