
WILD ASIAN WATER BUFFALO

Now found only in limited wetlands throughout National, India, Thailand, and Bhutan, the Wild Asian Water Buffalo stands 6 feet tall and can weigh more than 1 tor. Loss a habital, hunting, interbreeding with domestic buffalo, and cattle diseases have all contributed to this species decline. It is believed fewer than 1,000 remain in the wild.




















How to Garden for Wildlife...

Follow these easy steps to attract birds, butterflies and other wildlife to your own yard:

- 1. Grow native plants found in your area that offer food such as pollen, nectar, acorns, nuts, cones, berries and other seeds.
- Provide water for wildlife with a birdbath, small pond or shallow dish ... or take care of a natural spring or stream on or near your habitat.
- Create protective cover for wildlife by growing a meadow, a prairie or densely branched shrubs. Place hollow logs and rock piles in your yard.
- 4. Attach birdhouses to metal poles and monitor their use.

Please watch what you plant in your garden. Exotic species not native to your region can become invasive and can be harmful to both people and wildlife.



Penguin Profiles


